



Player Participation Disclaimer.

A. Participant Bound by Rules, Regulations and Policies of the Club, the League and FIDA

By Signing this Registration Form, the Participant;

- i. Agrees that they will comply with and observe the AFL Member Protection Policy, the Rules, Regulations and the Policies of the Club, the League and FIDA as they are presently constituted and as amended from time to time.
- ii. Acknowledges that they may inspect copies of the Rules, Regulations and the Policies of the Club, the League or FIDA on the FIDA, AFL and Club websites.
- iii. Acknowledges that his/her failure to adhere to the Rules, Regulations and the Policies of either the Club, the League or FIDA may result in him/her being de-registered and/or other sanctions, and;
- iv. Participants may upon request of the Club, League or FIDA be asked to provide proof of age.

B. Assumption of Risk

By Signing this Registration Form, the Participant acknowledges and agrees that;

- i. Australian Football is a vigorous body contact sport in which physical injury is likely to occur from time to time;
- ii. They are none the less desirous of playing Australian Rules Football for the Club, and;
- iii. They take upon themselves the risk (both physical and legal) of injury arising in the course of training for participating in the game of Australian Rules Football.

C. Requirements for Participant Registration

- i. All Participants must be registered with FIDA via PlayHQ before taking the field.
- ii. All Participants MUST also complete a current medical form and provide any medical certificates deeming the participant fit to play.
- iii. No Participants will be allowed to take the field without having fully completed the registration process.
- iv. Participants may be registered any time throughout the season. For a new participant to take the field, the registration must be completed no later than the Friday preceding the next round. NOT on match days. FIDA management must be notified of new players.
- v. A participant wishing to transfer to another team in the league must complete a transfer form. Transfer forms are available on request via email info@fida.org.au
- vi. A club may decline a participant to transfer if the participant is in possession of club property (jumper/shorts etc.) or owes the club money.
- vii. Special considerations will be accepted in reference to clearances.
