The FIDA Story

Imagine a world where there are no barriers to participate in your community and where you can have a kick and play footy with your team.

Imagine a world where your impairment doesn't matter. Where you will feel the same as everyone else when you step out on the field and have the same opportunities to kick a goal and celebrate your achievement.

FIDA (Football Integration Development Association) has been at the forefront of creating an inclusive community where individuals with intellectual impairments can actively participate in Australian Rules football without barriers. Over the past three decades, FIDA has worked tirelessly to promote equality and provide ample opportunities for these individuals to enjoy the sport on the same level as their peers.

It all began in 1989 when a simple footy clinic evolved into a fully-fledged league where athletes with an intellectual impairment could participate on equal terms. The initial competition, starting in 1991, featured six teams, and over time expanded to include clubs from both metropolitan and rural areas of Victoria, allowing for greater involvement and representation from all corners of the state.

Today, the FIDA league boasts a thriving community of over 800 players actively engaged in the sport. With 30 clubs strategically situated throughout metropolitan and country Victoria, the opportunities to participate in Australian Rules football have been made accessible to individuals with intellectual impairments across the State. As a result, players are empowered to approach the field with confidence, secure in the knowledge that they will be treated equitably, and provided equal opportunities to play the game they love and celebrate their achievements, just like any other athlete.

- for those with an intellectual impairment.





Key focus areas in the immediate future is to,

- identify a recurring revenue source to support the continued operational aspect of the league.
- consider the opportunity to link with a sporting organisation that has similiar aspiration in Australian rules football and has the financial equity to support the FIDA growth plan.
- consider widening the operating framework of FIDA to engage with a critical player mass and enable self-sustainability
- consider philanthropic opportunities that reasonate with sport and intellectual impairment.

The governance and ability to expand FIDA as an operating league and brand requires employed staff. It will be important to manage the expansion plan alongside the financial opportunities that present to support the strategic initiatives. There is also a risk that some activities may need to be delayed whilst funding is secured.

- sharing knowledge and resources to build resilience and excitement with the FIDA community.





































